INSURANCE REPORT

Duff Devine and Ona Micke reported that we may be lacking enough general liability coverage, as well as property, worker's comp and auto. These are not covered sufficiently in the USA Swimming policy. Tracy will check into the State Fund worker's comp to see what we have.

SUMMERDARTS UPDATE

Carolee reported that registration will be 4/16/09 from 6-8 pm. She has had fewer phone calls inquiring this year, despite advertising with fliers, banners, e-mails, and the Enterprise. There are 40 early applications. Registration night last year had 390 swimmers, for a total of 482 by the summer. Carolee is hoping for similar numbers, but this year may have fewer swimmers. She is hoping to give Jamie a salary increase this year as she has a big responsibility.

HEAD COACH'S REPORT

Brad reported that numbers are down a little bit from last year in the Blue and Bronze groups. He has hired a new coach, Michelle, for two months.

There were good performances at the Woodland and Junior Olympic meets in March. Several team records were broken.

The short course Sectional meet has been moved up from February 2010 to December 2009 in Long Beach. Long course season will then be moved forward as well. This will make it necessary to shorten the summer break for the senior swimmers by one week.

Brad has ordered new backstroke flags for Community pool. He will also purchase a new copier for the team.

HEAD COACH SEARCH UPDATE

Steve has placed an advertisement on the ASCA website for the month of April. There has been 24 applications so far, with 5 or 6 repeats from last fall.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Sally reported that the March – April budget is down and expenses are down. She is working on sending notices to families who are behind on dues and other charges. There was also some discussion about fees for Springdarts.
